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Project title	Building for the Future: Diagnostic & Treatment Centre for Moorfields at Stratford Moorfield Eye Hospital NHS Foundation Trust (MEH) Joint Working Project.

Project summary	The overall aim of this project is to partner with MEH on a discrete part of a large strategic refurbishment and redesign project. The substantive project is to convert a 4-floor office block situated on The Broadway (Stratford High St) to provide safe local care whilst delivering a high volume: low complexity service across all Ophthalmology conditions in the Northeast of the city. The overarching aim is to standardise care across MEH removing any unwarranted variation therefore reducing risk. The aspiration is that this project will create a model to roll out across the MEH centers.
Expected benefits to patients/patient care/NHS and Bayer	Patients - Intends to provide a suitable environment for the rapid access & delivery of diagnostics, treatment, and monitoring: - Increased number of patient slots for imaging and treatment from baseline. - Faster access to diagnostics and treatment for new patients. - Reduced patient time whilst in clinic compared to baseline. Moorfields NHS FT - Intends to improve productivity and efficiency through utilisation of available additional sessions from baseline. - Intends to deliver a sustainable patient pathway through workforce transformation. - Aims to support compliance with NICE targets for both Age-Related Macular Degeneration (AMD) and Diabetic Retinopathy and Retinal Vein Occlusion, by designing and implementing innovative referral pathways based on current NICE guidelines. - Intends to increase patient satisfaction & improve experience. Bayer - Demonstrating our commitment to ophthalmology patient care by collaborating on a large strategic project. - Increasing imaging and treatment capacity to support delivery of patient care in line with NICE guidelines (Bayer has a NICE approved treatment in this therapy area). - Opportunity to share learnings and best practice from this collaboration within the ophthalmology community to support service improvement in other locations.
