Project summary	<p>Coordinating organisations to work effectively with patients to prevent AF related strokes is a key priority for the AHSN.</p> <p>Yorkshire and Humber AHSN in partnership with Bayer through a joint working agreement wish to drive adoption of best practice from successful work across the National AHSN network. We will draw on the projects, tools and techniques already developed and evaluated in other parts of the country to effectively deliver an AF stroke prevention programme in primary care.</p> <p>The main focus of this initiative is to implement an AF focused Quality Improvement (QI) initiative in GP practices.
